Wood care

PINE OIL is an oil for maintenance of oil-finished pine wood and other light wooden furniture. The product helps protect the surface against drying out and leaves the furniture with a smooth, well-cared-for and dirt-repellent surface appearance. Completely raw and untreated surfaces may require repeated treatments to ensure sufficient saturation.

Key Benefits

- Designed for oak furniture and other light woods such as beech, pine and fir.
- Provides a hard wax surfaces with a silky, polished shine.
- Warms the appearance of the wood and emphasizes the natural grain structure.
- Helps impregnate and seam untreated wood when applied in repeated treatments.

Application area

For indoor oil-finished pine wood and other light wooden furniture where a smooth, maintained oil finish is desired. The product can also be used on completely raw or untreated light wooden surfaces, but these may require several applications to achieve sufficient saturation. Always test on a small, inconspicuous area before full application, as oil treatment may change the colour, gloss or surface feel of the wood.

Instructions

Ensure that the surface is clean, dry and free from dust, grease and loose residues before treatment. Apply PINE OIL with a soft cloth or brush in a thin and even layer. Allow the oil to penetrate the surface for approximately 15 minutes. Wipe off excess oil and polish with a clean, soft cloth. For raw or very absorbent surfaces, repeat the treatment if the wood does not appear saturated after the first application.
