Wood care

LINSEED OIL is a refined, heat-pressed linseed oil for treatment and maintenance of absorbent wooden surfaces. The oil penetrates into the wood, enhances the natural colour and structure, and helps reduce the dry appearance of untreated or worn wooden surfaces.

Key Benefits

- Made from 100% refined heat-pressed linseed oil.
- Enhances the natural wood structure and supports a warm, cared-for appearance.
- Penetrates into absorbent wood and helps nourish the surface.
- Enhances the natural colour, grain and character of the wood.
- Helps reduce the dry and faded appearance of untreated or worn wood.

Application area

For indoor solid wood surfaces where an oil treatment is desired, including wooden furniture, tabletops, countertops and similar absorbent wood surfaces. The product is intended for solid wood and is not recommended for lacquered, painted, sealed or non-absorbent surfaces unless suitability has been confirmed by testing. Always test on a small, inconspicuous area before full application, especially on light, sensitive or unknown wood types.

Instructions

Ensure that the surface is clean, dry and free from dust, grease and loose residues before treatment. Apply LINSEED OIL generously with a cloth or brush and distribute the oil evenly in the direction of the wood grain.

Allow the oil to penetrate the surface and wipe off all excess oil after approximately 1 hour. Do not leave excess oil to dry on the surface, as this may result in a sticky or uneven finish. New or dried-out wood may require repeated treatment. Allow the oil to harden for at least 24 hours between each application.
