Stone Care

GRANITE OIL is a clear oil for treatment and maintenance of granite and other hard, porous stone surfaces, such as unglazed tiles. The oil penetrates absorbent surfaces and helps enhance the natural structure and colour while reducing the dry or dull appearance of untreated or worn stone.

Key Benefits

- Clear oil treatment for granite and other porous hard stone surfaces.
- Enhances the natural colour, structure and depth of the surface.
- Helps protect absorbent stone against everyday dirt and drying out.
- Suitable for regular maintenance of untreated or previously oil-treated stone surfaces.

Application area

For absorbent hard stone surfaces such as granite and unglazed tiles. The product is intended for surfaces where the oil can penetrate and where a deeper, refreshed stone appearance is desired.

Do not use on glazed, sealed or non-absorbent surfaces where the oil cannot penetrate. The treatment may darken or change the appearance of porous stone. Always test on a small, inconspicuous area before full application.

Instructions

Wash the surface thoroughly with an alkaline cleaner and allow it to dry completely before treatment. Apply GRANITE OIL in an even layer with a cloth or brush. Repeat the treatment until the surface no longer absorbs oil.

Wipe off excess oil after a couple of hours. Do not leave excess oil to dry on the surface, as this may result in an uneven or sticky finish.
